

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

KARINGAL PARK UPGRADE AND NETBALL CLUBROOMS

WHAT IS PLANNED FOR THE PARK UPGRADE?

We anticipate the work will include:

- Clubrooms for Seaford Storm Netball Club
- Three open areas:
 - Space for ninja equipment, rope climbing tower and flying fox
 - Nature play space
 - A fitness equipment station
- Asphalt path with solar lighting
- New shelters with picnic tables
- BBO
- Seating benches and seats to be located throughout the park
- Dog bag dispenser units and bins
- Drinking fountain with dog bowl

HOW ARE OUR PARKS PLANNED?

Our Open Space Strategic Management Plan 2018-23 (OSSMP) guides the development of our parks and reserves. You can view the plan on Council's Your Say page under Documents.

This park has been identified by the OSSMP as a District Family Park, which is designed to provide a play area within easy walking distance.

There are a total of 240 playgrounds within the City of Onkaparinga and 18 of these are District Parks. There are also local, neighbourhood and regional parks.

Different types of open spaces are designed for different lengths of stays:

- Local up to 1 hour
- Neighbourhood 1-2 hours
- District 2-4 hours
- Regional full day

is an interactive map to show each park and reserve and their category as determined by the OSSMP.

WILL LIGHTING BE INCLUDED?

There will be solar lighting installed along the asphalt path.

HOW IS THE PROJECT BEING FUNDED?

Seaford Storm Netball Clubrooms

With the support of Chris Picton Member for Kaurna, the state government is contributing \$350,000 towards the construction of a new clubroom for Seaford Netball Club.

WHEN WILL IT BE CONSTRUCTED?

Construction is expected to be undertaken during the 2023-24 financial year.
