



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WILLUNGA ROSE GARDEN NEW TOILET BLOCK

BACKGROUND

The toilet at the Willunga Rose Garden has reached the end of its asset life and has been identified for an upgrade.

Why is the current toilet being replaced?

The existing toilet has reached the end of its asset life and currently has a high cost for maintenance.

Due to the popularity of the park and playgrounds and the frequency of tourist buses to this site, combined with the recent addition of the nature play space, the current facilities are not sufficient.

Why is there a new location for the toilet?

The current toilet is located within the historic railway and heritage precinct where it is not in keeping with the desired directions for this precinct.

The proposed location is located at the north-eastern corner of the carpark. Please refer to the map available on the Your Say page.

This location has been chosen:

- to not impede on the historic railway and heritage precincts.
- due to the availability of services i.e. water, electricity, sewer.
- due to the proximity to the carpark.
- due to the visibility, taking into account after hours security and lighting.
- considering the surrounding trees and vegetation.
- as it is close to the playgrounds and rose garden.

When can we expect the new toilet block to be built?

The construction completion estimated date is December 2020.

When will the existing toilet be removed?

The existing toilet will be kept in service until the new toilet block is ready for use.

The existing toilet will then be demolished and the area returned to natural ground.

What features does the new toilet block have?

- The new toilet block provides four toilet cubicles.
- The surroundings have been taken into consideration as part of the design so the architecture allows the toilet block to blend into the surrounds.
- The entry to the toilets will face away from the picnic area.
- The rear wall will have a planter box to soften the structure
- The texture on the building will match the texture on the water tower.
- The bricks on planter box will match the bricks on the BBQ's.
